## Hotels



The hotel closest to campus UiA is [Home Hotel Grimstad](#) which is located 2,5 km from UiA. You can take the bus (line 100, 101 or 140) from city centre to UiA campus in 10 minutes.



[Strand Hotel Fevik](#) is located just outside Grimstad, approximately 10 km from UiA.

Bus 101 takes you from the hotel to UiA campus in 17 minutes.



[Lillesand Hotel Norge](#) is also a nice hotel, located in our neighbour town, Lillesand. approximately 20 km from UiA, 17 min. by car.

Bus between Grimstad and Lillesand (line 100 – bus stop Viadukten) runs twice an hour.

## Boat Trip

In nice sunny weather, M/S Øya will take us on a 3-hour tour through the beautiful Grimstad archipelago. During the trip we'll be served a delicious dinner made from fresh, local ingredients. Beverages can be purchased on board.

M/S Øya takes 99 people, there is plenty of space, and you can sit on the front deck, in the closed saloon below or on the sun deck above, also under cover.
